Duties and Responsibilities:

- Supervise Owner's greens maintenance crew (the "Crew"), which shall include, but not be limited to, hiring of personnel for the Crew, scheduling of Crew work hours and duties to be performed, scheduling of irrigation, fertilization, aeration and other Course maintenance activities.
- Supervise and assure that the grass on the Course is properly fertilized, treated, reseeded, cut and maintained by the Crew and instruct the Crew as to the proper times and methods for performing such cutting.
- Supervise and assure that the Course is properly watered by the Crew, and instruct the Crew as to the proper times to perform such watering, and the proper amounts and methods for performing such watering; and prepare a manual reflecting the components comprising, and the location of such components, of the watering system and the requirements to properly provide such watering.
- Supervise, maintain and assure that all of the Club's equipment, tools, carts, etc are serviced and kept in optimum working order in accordance with the cart lease agreement.
- Supervise and assist with the opening and closing of the Club's facilities, including winterization of equipment and related buildings.
- Meet, on a weekly basis, with designated representatives of Owner's greens committee to discuss and disclose maintenance issues, schedules and progress. Review daily the needs and concerns of the pro shop manager to ensure his functions are properly addressed.
- The applicant is aware that this position requires a hands on approach as well as the supervision of others to complete the daily tasks.

Applicants must be experienced and hold all licenses and certifications necessary to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of such position. Opening is for immediate availability and is normally a 7 month position. Salary commensurate with experience.
